Instructions for Visiting the United States Mint at Denver

Visitors must be at the tour entrance 30 minutes before tour time. Late arrivals will not be admitted.

All visitors are subject to a security screening, to include metal detection and x-ray examination of hand-carried items. **The Mint does not provide storage for any items.**

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Handbags, purses, fanny packs, backpacks and packages
- Strollers
- Food, drink, tobacco products, lighters and matches
- Weapons (including pocket knives and personal protective devices)

Permitted items:

- Palm sized wallet that can fit in your pocket and umbrellas
- Cameras and cell phones (use of these items is prohibited while inside the Mint building).
- Medical necessities

Remember that virtually nothing can be carried into the Mint. A small billfold that can be carried in your pocket with identification, credit cards or cash is all that is permitted so remember to leave the rest of your things at home.

The Mint does have a nice gift shop so do bring spending money!

The Denver Mint is located at 320 West Colfax Avenue. Tour entrance is on Cherokee St.
