The Winter Snow Camping Overnight Campout will be held in Rocky Mountain National Park on January 28-29, 2017. We will meet at the Scout Hut on Saturday at 8:00 AM and drive in personal cars to Moraine Park Campground in Rocky Mountain National Park where we will be sleeping in tents. (An alternate destination may be chosen if weather or road conditions dictate.) The scouts will be participating in various physical activities on Saturday that may involve strenuous activity. Upon arrival at the Park we will set up camp and then go on a snowshoe hike. While on the hike we will melt snow on a backpack stove to make soup. Upon return to the campground, we will cook dinner and have a campfire. We will return to the Scout Hut on Sunday about noon.

Winter camping conditions will be likely so make sure that you have appropriate clothes and sleeping gear. **Be prepared!** Scouts will be sleeping in tents and the temperature could well drop below zero degrees. There will be pit toilets, but no heated indoor facilities. Participants should have a good winter sleeping bag and insulating ground pad. A fleece sleeping bag liner might be a good idea. Participants should bring all clothing and equipment items on the winter packing list. In particular, they should have plenty of warm (wool or polypropylene) socks and a dry pair of long underwear to change into before going to bed. Note they must have two pairs of boots.

Precautions to provide a safe and enjoyable experience will be taken, but there can be no guarantee of absolute safety against injury or accident. In recognition of the inherent risks of attending the Winter Snow Camping Overnight Campout, I (and for or on behalf of my child participant) assume full responsibility for personal injury, accidents and illness, including death, that may occur from my child's (or my) participation.

I acknowledge that I understand the risks associated with participating in the Winter Snow Camping Overnight Campout (whether outlined herein or not) and do hereby release, forever discharge and agree to hold harmless the Boy Scouts of America, Troop 114 and any of its adult leaders from any and all liability, claims or demands for personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damage and expenses, of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by me or my child while participating in the Winter Snow Camping Overnight Campout.
