New Business

Gear Wish List

1. Due to the efforts of Stephen Forinash, the Elks Lodge has donated \$250 to Troop 114G
2. A donation of 3 commercially built patrol camping boxes, at substantial expense, as been authorized to be ordered. The funds for this expense are being generously donated by the Beatson family and the Committee has accepted this offer. Mr. Beatson is coordinating the ordering and payment for these boxes.
3. Approval by vote for Scotty Nash to purchase with Troop funds, appropriate carrying bags for the camp stoves and an additional camp stove.

Help Wanted

1. Christy Beatson agreed to be the lead person to handle the Journey to Excellence data for the Troop. Earning this award can allow for the troop to obtain rank advancement patches at no cost.
2. Stephen Forinash agreed to be the Troop adult Quartermaster.
3. Ed Avery and Stephen Forinash to have future discussion regarding the position of Advancement Chairperson, responsibilities and the fulfillment of that position.
4. Acceptance and review of Medical form responsibilities have been accepted by Chris Forinash.

First Aid Merit Badge

1. Notification from Scotty Nash that Dr. Kern Buckner has agreed to present a 2 hour First Aid Merit Badge class at Bemis Library on Monday, April 15, 2019 from 6:00-8:00PM. All girls from T-114G are invited to attend and boys from Troop 114 are also invited to attend. Those attending should be able to complete the badge provided that any prerequisite and post class requirements, if any, are completed.

Spring Camp @ PV 4/12/Sand Dunes 5/17

1. Explanation of food purchase requirements for rank advancement, and the structure of completing those requirements for the next campout, so that more scouts can complete those requirements were explained. This means that different scouts (with their parents) may be purchasing food for specific meals in their patrols, rather than one scout purchasing the food for the entire patrol meals.
